INSTRUCTIONS / GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS

1. Details must be submitted latest by **15th October 2024** to ensure the smooth conduction of the event.
2. The **First round of matches** will commence on **25th October 2024 at 12.00 noon sharp.**
3. Teams will be provided accommodation on the school premises.
4. Teams will be responsible for their personal belongings and are advised not to carry any jewellery, cash or valuable items.
5. Teams are encouraged to stay at the school premises for the smooth conduct of the event .Teams opting to stay outside will be responsible for any incidents/mishaps that may occur.
6. Dress code within the playing arena will be House/Sports dress of respective schools.
7. Players must report to the officials for their attendance **45 minutes prior** to the scheduled time of event.
8. The Girls' team must be accompanied by a female teacher at all times.
9. All the teams are requested to bring :
 - **Lock-key**
 - **Torch**
 - **Recently clicked two passport sized photographs**
 - **Two School flags**
 - **School placard**
 - **Student Identity Cards for each player**
 - **School Uniform**
 - **Chess clocks**
 - **Proof of payment of ANNUAL SPORTS FEE 2024-25.**
10. **Only Vegetarian Food** will be served during the event.
11. No team will be allowed to participate without a Team Manager/Coach.

12. IMPORTANT:IT SHALL BE MANDATORY FOR ALL THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING ON ARRIVAL AT VENUE-

- a. A Team Photograph with School Principal along with the Entry Proforma, countersigned by the concerned Principal(verification format provided).
- b. For students/players studying in class IX and above,it is liable to provide CBSE Registration Number ,Eligibility/Entry Proforma & ID Card.
- c. A signed copy of Eligibility Proforma (filled online)to the Host School on arrival.
- d. Original Online Team Entry Forms attested by the School Principal.
- e. CBSE Registration Card or online printout of the participants' registration.
- f. Copy of Aadhaar Card for each participant.
- g. Copy of School ID Card for each participant (students must carry their original School ID Card).



INSTRUCTIONS/GUIDELINES FOR COACHES/MANAGERS

- a. All coaches/managers must carry recently clicked passport sized photographs and must have their I-cards(issued by Organizing Committee)available at all times.
- b. In case of Girl participants,one of the accompanying officials must be a female.**
- c. The parents/guardians accompanying the team shall have a valid Identity Card issued by their School Principal and an authority letter on the school letter head.**
- d. After registration, players of any team are not permitted to leave the school premises without permission.
- e. If the coach or manager of any team wishes to leave the school, they must inform the Organizing Committee.
- f. **No extra members** will be allowed with the team apart from the officially registered players and staff.
- g. Friends or relatives of participants will not be permitted to enter the school premises during the competition.
- h. Team members are responsible for safeguarding their own valuables. The school will not be held liable for any lost or stolen items.
- i. Kindly cooperate in keeping the school premises clean.
- j. Any form of intoxication is strictly prohibited within the school premises. If any participant, coach, or manager is found consuming drugs, alcohol, or similar substances, severe disciplinary action will be taken.
- k. It is prohibited to bring any kind of outside food into the school rooms or from the canteen. All food must be consumed only in the designated eating areas.
- l. If any school property is damaged or destroyed by a member of any team, the team will be disqualified, and a formal complaint will be lodged with the CBSE. Our school is highly valued, and such behavior will not be tolerated.
- m. When asked by the Organizing Committee, you must provide a full introduction of any team member. This is mandatory for security purposes.
- n. Meals will only be provided with a meal coupon and within the specified serving times.
- o. Discipline is the top priority. Teams are expected to form lines and wait for their turn at meal distribution points. Indiscipline will result in strict action, as we maintain a zero-tolerance policy on such matters.
- p. Food will not be served after the scheduled time indicated on the meal coupons. Ensure that you adhere to the time schedule.
- q. It is mandatory for all team members to participate in the opening and closing ceremony of the competition.
- r. It is mandatory for all the contestants to wear their school uniform in the opening and closing ceremony of the event.
- s. Photographing or recording the competition using mobile phones or any electronic devices is strictly prohibited. If caught, the device will be confiscated and disciplinary action will be taken (Zero tolerance for such activity).However, you are permitted to take photos of the players only when they are receiving medals or awards.
- t. If any coach, manager, or team member is found disturbing others using mobile phones or other electronic gadgets, disciplinary action will be taken.
- u. Movement on the school campus after the designated time is not permitted. Team members must remain in their allotted rooms unless given permission by the Organizing Committee.
- v. Coaches and managers must provide emergency contact details to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.
- w. Any team member needing medical attention should immediately report to the medical facility on the premises. Coaches and managers should monitor the health of their team members.



- x. Ensure your team is aware of the match schedules and is ready at the venue at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time.
- y. If any issues arise, coaches or managers should directly contact the event organizers or designated officials. Avoid making independent decisions that may affect the smooth functioning of the event.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

A player or team may be disqualified or scratched for the following reasons:

1. **Ineligibility:** If any member of the team is found to be ineligible to participate.
2. **Non-bonafide Students:** If a non-bona fide student is included in the team.
3. **Misbehavior on the FOP(Field of Play):** Misconduct or inappropriate behavior by players or accompanying officials on the field.
4. **Use of Abusive Language:** Usage of offensive or abusive language by players or accompanying officials.
5. **Misbehavior with Officials/Opponents:** Any form of misconduct or disrespect towards officials or opposing teams by players or accompanying officials.
6. **Indiscipline at the Place of Stay:** Acts of indiscipline or inappropriate behavior by players or accompanying officials at the accommodation facility.
7. **Damage to School Property:** Any damage caused to the property of the host school by players or accompanying officials.
8. **False Documentation:** Submission of false documents or certificates will result in immediate disqualification, and the school will face disciplinary actions.
9. **Dispute Resolution:** Any disputes or grievances must be addressed through the official protest procedure. No informal discussions or confrontations will be entertained.
10. **Respect for Rules:** Coaches, managers, and players are expected to respect and abide by the rules and regulations set by the organizing committee and CBSE. Failure to do so will result in penalties.
11. **Time Management:** Teams must adhere strictly to the schedule of events. Delayed reporting or no-shows may result in disqualification.
